- All coaching positions filled, except in u12 and u14B

Summer Program

- Program now finished
- Good feedback from parents.
- Some teenage coaches stepped up, great to see.
- There are around \$3k owing in coaches payments.
- Numbers approx. 30 per age group per night.
- It was noted that the Summer and Holiday programs are an important revenue stream for the club and also keeps players engaged with the club/sport.

MiniRoos Boys

3. Equipment – ground allocations
