- Player registrations down, due to Covid refunds for 2020 playing year processed in the 20/21 Financial year
- Canteen & fundraising balance out from 2020
- Sponsorship down due to Covid and the impact on businesses not about to financially support the club

Expenses

- Overall expenses down by \$100k due to Covid and no games played in 2020 which impacted mainly on the 20/21 financial year figures
- Affiliation & registration fees up by \$25k some of the FFV refunds were carried over from Covid
- Pitch Rent down by \$40k due to no charge for the playing year of 2020, there will be an increase in this financial year however we were charged at a reduced rate
- No trophies and presentations expenses
- Coaching fees down by \$40k
